Violence Prevention and Intervention Activities and Strategies**

- Early identification of students with challenging behaviors and implementation of appropriate interventions
- Counseling and support services for students with challenging behaviors by campus social workers and counselors
- Staff training to assist in developing and implementing strategies and prevention-based interventions for students with challenging behaviors
- Training for students in conflict resolution
- Implementation of Positive Behavior Support Management System
- Reinforcement of positive behavior through recognition and incentives
- Implementation of drug awareness programs district-wide through presentations and age-appropriate activities
- Individualized support to struggling students and parents through District Social Services
- Installation of security lighting and surveillance cameras at campuses
- Communication with appropriate community agencies regarding student issues when determined necessary by persons responsible
- Contraband detection through canine searches
- Random drug testing
- Placements in DAEP and JJAEP as determined by TEC Chapter 37 and local Student Code of Conduct
